



## Teddy bear onesie



Size: 0/3 months

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 4 balls (each ball 50g and 170m) of Baby Soft yarn (100% Extrafine Merino Wool. Machine Washable. Processed with Aloe Vera. Shrinkproof) shade no. 978

Hooks: A 3.75mm crochet hook
A 4.50mm crochet hook

**Sewing needle:** Yarn needle with rounded point **Other items:** 4 buttons, 5 stitch-markers.

## **STITCHES**

Using hook: Chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Half treble (htr) - Treble (tr)

RIDGE HALF TREBLE BACK (RHTRB): work 1 htr inserting

hook into back loop only of previous row.

FRONT POST TREBLE (FPTR): yarn on hook, insert hook around stem of treble from front to back, yarn on hook and pull through a loop, (yarn on hook and pull through two loops on hook) twice.

## **TENSION**

27 sts and 17 rows measure 10cm square over ridge half treble back (RhtrB) stitch with 3.75mm hook. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Note: Work top down.

Main part: with 3.75mm hook ch79 and, starting from 3rd ch from hook, work as follows: 1st row: 12 htr, 1 double inc (= 3 htr into same ch or st) into next ch, placing 1 stitch-marker on centre htr, 15 htr, I double inc into next ch, placing I stitch-marker on centre htr, 20 htr, 1 double inc into next ch, placing 1 stitch-marker on centre htr, 15 htr, 1 double inc into next ch, placing 1 stitch-marker on centre htr, 12 htr; ch2, turn. Note: at end of each row, work 2 turning ch throughout. 2nd row: work in RhtrB st and work a double inc into each of 4 centre st (of 3htr group) indicated with a stitch marker. 3rd row: work in RhtrB st without increasing. 4th row: work in RhtrB st with 4 double incs (as given in 2nd row). From 5th to 20th row: rep 3rd (without incs) and 4th (with 4 incs) rows 8 times. There are 166 sts. 21st row: open armholes. Work in RhtrB st until to first stitch-marker, into this st work 1 RhtrB, ch3, miss next sts and work 1 RhtrB into next stitch-marker st, cont in RhtrB st until to next stitch-marker, into this st work 1 RhtrB, ch3, miss

next sts and work 1 RhtrB into next stitch-marker st, cont in RhtrB st until to end. 22nd row: work in RhtrB st and work 1 htr into each of 6 ch (3 ch for 1st armhole and 3 ch for 2nd armhole). From 23rd to 32nd row: work in RhtrB st. 33rd row: work \* 1 RhtrB into each of next 5 sts, 2 RhtrB into next st (= 1 inc); rep from \* to end. 34th and 35th row: work in RhtrB st. 36th row: work \* 1 RhtrB into each of next 7 sts, 2 RhtrB into next st (= 1 inc); rep from \* to end. From 37th to 65th row: work in RhtrB st. Now, for legs, divide work in half and place 1 stitch-marker on centre stitch. 66th row: work in RhtrB st until to stitch-marker just placed (= first leg); turn. From 67th to 86th round: work in RhtrB st on sts of 1st Leg, start each round with ch2 (= first st), end each round with a ss into first st (= 2nd of ch2) and turn. Then, for **border** work: **1st round:** \* 2 tr closed tog (= 1 dec); rep from \* all around, ending with a ss into first st. Turn work at end of every round and work ch3 (= first tr) at beg of each round. From **2nd to** 6th round: work \* 1 tr, 1 FPtr; rep from \* to end. Fasten off. Work 2nd Leg in the same manner.

**Sleeves:** (make 2) for each sleeve, starting from 2nd of armhole 3 ch, with 3.75mm hook work 28 rounds in RhtrB st, as given for Legs. Work Cuff as leg Border.

**Hood:** with 3.75mm hook work on opposite side of starting ch on Main Part. Join yarn to first st with a ss and work 40 rows in RhtrB st. At end, fasten off. **Note:** If you prefer to obtain a larger hood, inc 1 st every 4 sts across 1st row.

**Ears:** (make 2) work with two strands of yarn held together and 4.50mm hook. Make a magic ring and, into this ring, work: **1st round:** 12 trebles; end with 1 ss into first st. At beg of each round ch3 (= first tr). **2nd round:** 1 inc (= 2 tr into same st) in each st (there are 24 tr). **3rd round:** 24 tr. Fasten off. Fold hood in half and sew side seam.

Opening and hood border: starting and ending from a leg work a row of trebles and a row as follows: \* 1 tr, 1 FPtr; rep from \* to end. At the same time, on left (or right) side of border open 4 buttonholes: the first, 1cm from hood beg, the last 2cm from legs and the others evenly spaced. For each buttonhole, ch1 instead of 1 tr. At end, fasten off. Sew 4 buttons on opposite border side, in correspondence. Sew ears to hood sides, as shown in picture.

**Note:** wash garment carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the garment to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.
